

Video title: Basic Disk to Dynamic Disk Conversion

Step 1	Description
#1 Video 1	Right-click on My Computer and click Manage . The Computer Management window will open.
#2 Video 1	In the Left window pane click Disk Management . In the lower portion of the right hand side, right-click on Disk 0 Basic and Click Upgrade to Dynamic Disk
#3 Video 1	The Upgrade to Dynamic Disk window will appear. Be sure there is a check mark in the box next to Disk 0 and click OK . The next window is Disk to Upgrade, check to be sure the information is correct and click Upgrade .
#4 Video 1	A window will appear called Disk Management. It will ask "Are you sure you want to upgrade?" click Yes . One last warning will appear about dismounting the file system. Click Yes . Click OK to reboot this will complete the upgrade process.
Step 2	
#5 Video 2	Once the computer reboots, log back on. A System Settings Change window will appear, stating Windows 2000 has installed new devices and will need to restart. Click Yes .
#6 Video 2	Once the computer reboots, log back on. Navigate back to the Disk Management screen (using the steps above).
#7 Video 2	Notice where it says Disk 0, it now says Dynamic instead of Basic. The conversion is complete.
